- Candidate must have completed Intermediate (12 years of education) in the Pre-Medical group.
- At least 50% marks in Science subjects, as per PNMC criteria.
- Candidates must qualify the College Entry Test.
- Merit list will be prepared strictly on the basis of Entry Test results.
- Final admission is subject to verification of original documents and PNMC eligibility requirements.
