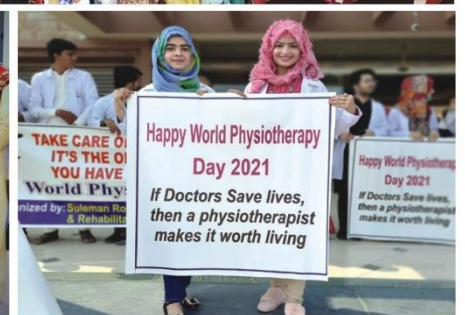
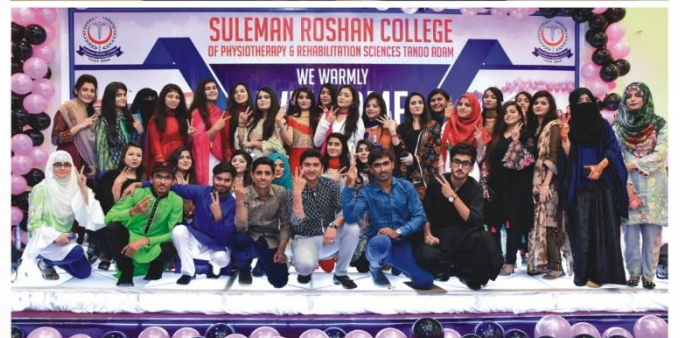

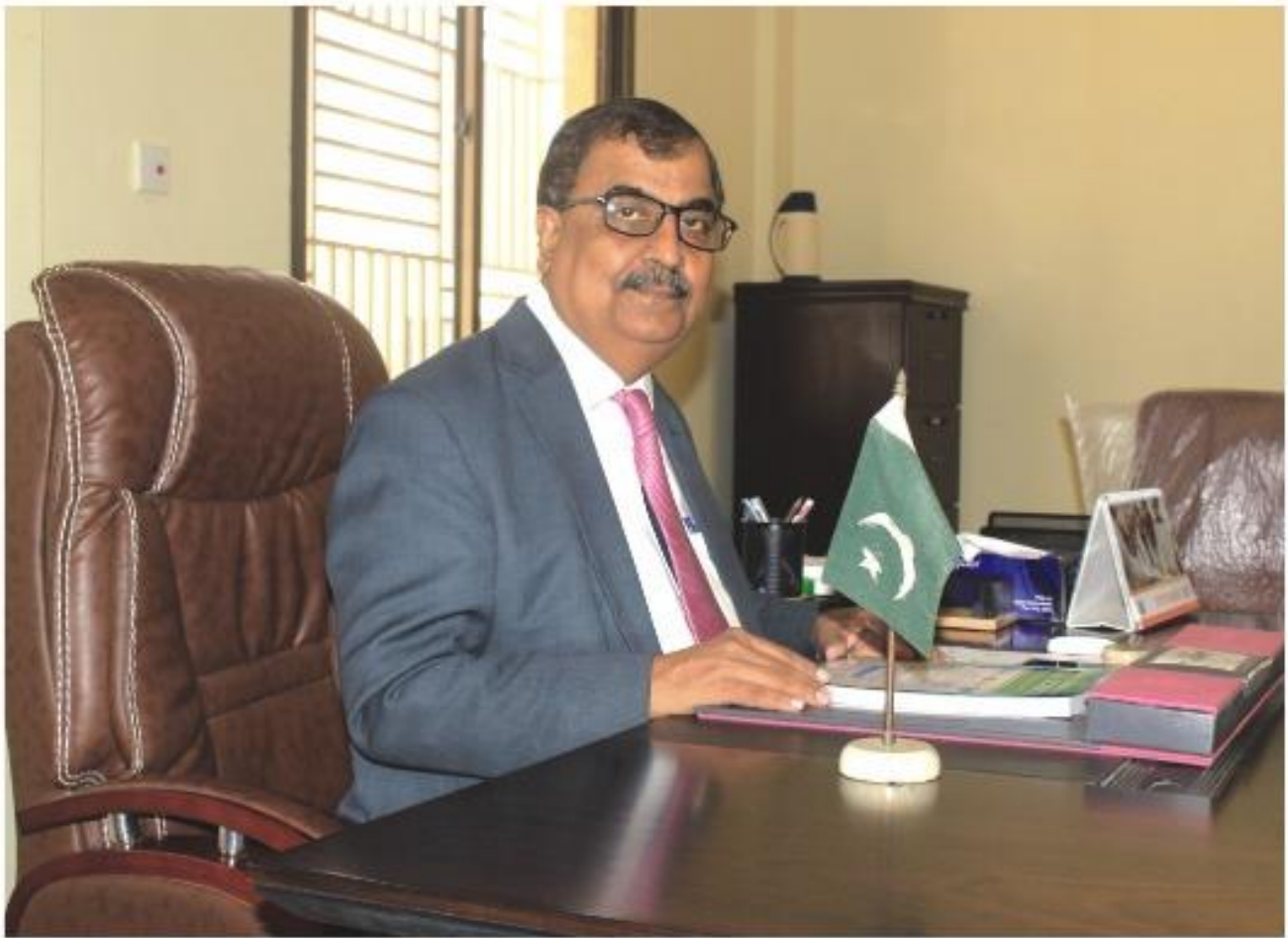

PHYSICAL THERAPY

Physical Therapy (PT), mostly known as Physiotherapy, is a primary care specialty in medicine that, by using mechanical force and movements [Bio-mechanics or Kinesiology], Manual therapy, exercise therapy, electro therapy and various physical therapies who practice evidence based treatments, remediates impairments and promotes mobility, function, and quality of life through examination, diagnosis, prognosis, and physical intervention. It is performed by physical therapists (known as physiotherapists in many countries). In



addition to clinical practice, other activities encompassed in the physical therapy profession include research, education, consultation, and administration. Physical therapy services may be provided as primary care treatment or alongside, or in conjunction with, other medical services.



GENERAL SCOPE OF PRACTICE

Physiotherapy provides services to individuals and populations to develop, maintain, restore and optimize health and function throughout the lifespan. This includes providing services to people compromised by ageing, injury, disease or environmental factors. Physiotherapy identifies and maximizes quality of life and movement potential by using the principles of **p r o m o t i o n , p r e v e n t i o n ,** treatment/intervention, habilitation and rehabilitation. This encompasses physical, psychological, emotional, and social well being. Physiotherapy involves the interaction between physiotherapists, patients/clients, other health professionals, families, care givers, and communities. This is a people-centered process where needs are assessed and goals are agreed using the knowledge and



skills of physiotherapists.

Physiotherapists are health practitioners who are educated to practice autonomously by applying scientific knowledge and clinical reasoning to assess, diagnose and manage human function.

The practice of physiotherapy is not confined to clinical practice, and encompasses all roles that a physiotherapist may assume such as patient/client care, health management, research, policy making, educating and consulting, wherever there may be an issue of public health and safety.

Physiotherapy specialists are expert physiotherapists who have advanced education, knowledge and skills to practice within a specific area of clinical practice like:

7. Demonstrate leadership, management, and communication skills to effectively participate in physical therapy practice and the health care team.
8. Incorporate and demonstrate positive attitudes and behaviors to all persons.
9. Demonstrate the professional and social skills to adapt to changing health care environments to effectively provide physical therapy care.

RULES OF ADMISSION

Applications for admission in 1st year DOCTOR OF PHYSIOTHERAPY (DPT) shall be invited through advertisement in the leading newspapers containing all the necessary information and prescribing dates of issuance/sale of prospectus & application form and submission of applications.

I. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. The admission in DOCTOR OF PHYSIOTHERAPY (DPT) will purely be on merit bases. The candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary School certificate pre-medical with science subjects biology, chemistry, and physics, or 'A' level during last 02 years and have secured at least 60% marks (B-Grade) in aggregate from any Board of Higher Secondary Education in Pakistan or any institution from foreign countries duly recognized by inter board committee of chairman (IBCC) are eligible to apply for admission.
2. Candidate should be permanent resident of any District of Pakistan.
3. Age ranging from 17 to 23 years at the time of submission of application form.
4. Medium of instruction /teaching of course shall be English.

II. ENTRY TEST

The entry test shall be conducted from the prescribed intermediate syllabus of Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, all over the Pakistan. There will be 100 multiple choice questions in the test they will be distributed in the following manner:

The time allotted to solve the paper will be 100 minutes.

- Each correct answer shall be awarded 04 (four) marks and there will be 01 negative mark for each incorrect answer.
- The candidates shall collect admit-slip for the Entry Test from the Admission cell of SRCP&RS, Tando Adam, Sindh.



III. FORMULA FOR WORKING OUT THE OVERALL MERIT

- a) Metric Science/O level/equivalent 10% weightage
- b) HSC (Pre-Medical)/equivalent examination 40% weightage
- c) Entry test 50% weightage

Note: Only science subject pre-medical (Biology, Chemistry & Physics) will be considered in HSC result for making District merit list.

Example:

If a candidate has obtained following marks:

- a) Metric Science/O level equivalent examination 650/680 or 95.58 %
- b) HSC/A level equivalent (Science subject only) 440/600 or 73.33 %
- c) Entry Test marks 300/400 or 75.00 %

His/Her merit will be calculated as follows:

- a) Weightage for SSC/O level/equivalent =95.58% *0.1=9.55%
 - b) Weightage for HSC =73.33% *0.4=29.33%
 - c) Weightage for Entry Test =75.00% *0.5=37.50%
- Over all merit of the candidate =a+b+c=9.55+29.33+37.5=76.38%

All calculations in percentages will be rounded up to two decimal points.

RULES OF EXAMINATIONS

1. The Students having minimum 75% attendance and cleared all dues of fees will be eligible to appear in the semester examinations. Any student who fails to maintain minimum attendance as prescribed by the SRCP&RS, Tando Adam, Sindh for appearance, his/her examination form shall not be forwarded to the Controller of Examination.
2. Beside the semester examinations, two internal evaluation tests after every 06 weeks study will be conducted and students should secure at least 60% marks in each test.
3. The organization of semester system is given below.

PROMOTION POLICY

- *Promotion from one academic year to next higher academic year.*
- *Policy of conducting Re-sit (repeat) examination.*

FIRST AND SECOND SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS

First Semester students who after appearing in First Semester (Regular) examination, either declared pass or fail will be allowed promotion to Second Semester.

Upon promotion in Second Semester, students who have either passed or failed in First Semester examination both will be allowed to appear in Second Semester examination.

Pending result of Second Semester examination, if the classes for Third Semester are commenced, students of Second Semester (Either passed or failed in first semester) will be allowed to attend the classes of Third semester.

After announcement of Second Semester examination result, students of First and Second Semesters will fall in the following groups:

- a) Passed First and Second Semesters.
- b) Passed Second Semester but failed in First Semester.
- c) Passed First Semester but failed in Second Semester
- d) Failed in both the Semesters.

Students under category b, c and d will then be allowed re-sit examinations of First and Second Semesters simultaneously while they remain under study process of Third Semester.

After announcement of re-sit (repeat) examinations result of both first and second semesters, the students will be bifurcated into the following groups:

- 1) Passed first and Second semester's examinations completely they will continue in Third Semester.
- 2) Students who failed either in First Semester or in Second Semester or both semester examinations shall be reverted i.e. termed back to First Semester or Second Semester.

Above group of students of DPT after term "b" will repeat the failure subject(s) of Semester I or II With junior batch.

IMPORTANT: In case of their failure in subject(s) of 1st/2nd or both Semesters with junior batch (repeat examination) they shall cease to be eligible for further education in SRCP&RS, TANDOADAM, SINDH.


NOTE: This system applies to all the semesters in all the five years (ten semesters).



CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINARY RULES OF SULEMAN ROSHAN COLLEGE OF PHYSIOTHERAPY & REHABILITATION SCIENCES

SRCP&RS, Tando Adam, Sindh has prescribed Students Discipline Conduct, Welfare and Code of Honor Regulations and the same will be applicable to the Doctor of Physiotherapy students and will be dealt with strictly in accordance with these rules.

1. A student whose name appears in the F.I.R pertaining to any non-bail able offence as specified in the criminal procedure code by concealing the facts seeks admission, and if at any stage the facts are detected he/she will be liable to disciplinary action and will be suspended. During the pendency of the case he/she will not be allowed to attend classes or appear in any evolutionary internal test or examination.
2. The action for situations warranting suspension, rustication or expulsion will be according to the specific procedures as follows:
 - a. The Institute may initiate action against any student of the SRCP&RS and recommend the case to the Disciplinary Committee of the SRCP&RS, Tando Adam, Sindh, for his/her Suspension, rustication or expulsion, as the case may be.
 - b. Before taking any action, the Principal shall serve a show cause notice to the student indicating briefly the charge(s) against his/her. The concerned student will have to submit a written reply within seven days of the issuance of the SCN and in case of default the matter will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee of the SRCP&RS.
 - c. If a student fails to submit tuition or other prescribed fees within the specified time, will be liable to penalty @ Rs. 5000/- per month. However he/she will have to deposit fee within 30 days. In case of further default in submission of tuition fees he/she will be liable to disciplinary action which includes his/her expulsion from the SRCP&RS.
 - d. A student who remains absent for more then fortnight or for a longer period will be liable to disciplinary action which includes his/her suspension and expulsion from the SRCP&RS.
3. **STUDENTS CONDUCT RULES**
 - i) No student shall form society/association/organization.
 - ii) No outside person will be invited by the students to address any meeting of the students gathering.
 - iii) No student union will be formed.
 - iv) The Principal of the SRCP&RS can issue disciplinary orders of permanent or temporary nature against the student who render himself/herself liable to disciplinary action.

- 
- v) Any student wishing to publish any scientific or literary article, he/she must seek approval of the draft from Principal and shall have to submit the copy of the draft/transcript for record of the SRCP&RS.
 - vi) Students will not be allowed to address the national press on the following subjects:
 - a. Political or allied subjects
 - b. Matters directly or indirectly connected with the administration of the SRCP&RS, Tando Adam, Sindh.
 - c. Matters pertaining to the policies of the Government.
 - vii) Students are forbidden to address higher authorities directly. Any communication intended for higher authorities needs to be enrouted through proper channel.
 - viii) SRCP&RS is "NO SMOKING ZONE" Smoking and use of Pan, Ghutka, Mainpuri & Narcotics, and other activities prejudicial to the conduct of the class are prohibited.

4. **SUSPENSION**

A student shall be liable for suspension up to six months if he/she commit any of the following acts:

- i) Uses unfair means during examination: The Principal can suspend any student who is found indulging in unfair means during examination. Further action against him/her will be taken by the Committee for breach of the rules and regulations.
- ii) Misbehaves or quarrels with any teacher or member of the staff.
- iii) Is generally disobedient.
- iv) Spreads false rumors.
- v) Uses unbecoming, indecent or filthy language.
- vi) Incite other students to violence.
- vii) Is inappropriately dressed.
- viii) Shouts, abuses, quarrels or fights with fellow students.
- ix) Raises slogans to hurt others, politically or religiously.
- x) Interferes with the administration including the mode or schedule of the examination.
- xi) Indulges in acts of immorality.
- xii) Indulges in any kind of political activity including displaying posters or play cards and chalking in any part of the SRCP&RS, Tando Adam, Sindh.
- xiii) Remain absent continuously for more than three weeks without prior permission.

5. **RUSTICATION**

A student may be rusticated by the Disciplinary Committee of the SRCP&RS for a period of three years due to any of the following acts.

- i) Taking forceful possession, making unauthorized use or damaging any property.



- ii) Involving him-self in any agitational activity.
- iii) Found indulging in activities, prejudicial and detrimental to the good order of the SRCP&RS, Tando Adam, Sindh.
- iv) Adopting unfair means during examination.
- v) Disobeying an order of suspension passed against him/her.
- vi) Any other act, which the Disciplinary Committee considers inappropriate.
- vii) Anybody who does not submit the prescribed undertaking about non-involvement the political activities.

6. EXPULSION

A student is liable to be expelled from the SRCP&RS by the Disciplinary Committee if he/she commits any of the following acts:

- i) Is found in possession of fire arms or lethal weapons or Narcotics drugs in the college premises, examination hall or any other area as specified by the SRCP&RS administration.
- ii) Remains absent for more than three months without permission of the Principal, his/her admission shall be cancelled.
- iv) Is convicted by a court of law for any criminal act.

NOTE: I. Any student suspended or rusticated for the reasons mentioned above shall not be allowed to appear in the examination.

II. The orders of rustication and expulsion shall be final and irrevocable.
